

Sandy Beach Commission Rules

Obey Lifeguards

No alcohol

No pets on the beach

No floatation devices (e.g. lifejackets, etc.)

No masks, snorkles, or flippers

Swim only in marked area

Non-swimmers not allowed on raft

No running or horseplay on raft

Use ladders on raft

One person on slide at a time

No t-shirts or extra clothing on raft

Keep clear of lifeguard stand/chair

No assisted swimming to raft

Swimmers must be tested to access raft
